

About She Legend

From ancient amazons to superheroes in comics and current Hollywood blockbusters, fighting women appear as a fetishized projection screen. The medial depiction of heroes and superheroes becomes a metaphor for gender stereotypes and traditional role models: on the one hand, the woman as a male eating hyena or as fighting girl with short panties and a crazy look, on the other side the man as a pumped up muscular world-savior, who opposes the evil.

In their new production SHE LEGEND, the choreographer duo Rykena/Jüngst is whirling up the queer potential of the comic world and confusing traditional heroic ideals. The performers transform into well-known and unknown heroes and superheroes, become retro-futuristic hybrid beings and invent new superpowers. Oscillating between multiplicities and cyborgs, they interrogate their own heroism and embody non-conformist figures who fight for the abolition of masculinized (single)heroism.

Carolin Jüngst

Since 2016 Carolin Jüngst & Lisa Rykena are working together as a collective as well as freelancing performers and choreographers in Hamburg, Munich and Berlin. In their work the Duo Rykena/Jüngst is dealing with gueerfeminist body discourses and the transformation of normative body ascriptions. In their pieces they go back to classic, mythological and popultural material to create new figures, hybrid forms and grotesque embodyments. Their last common work ARIE/ELLE was produced in 2018 in the frame of the residency "Limited Edition" at K3 | Tanzplan Hamburg. Kampnagel. Lisa Rykena studied classical and contemporary dance at the HfMDK in Frankfurt am Main. She performed in works by William Forsythe, Zufit Simon, Ursina Tossi and collaborates regularly with the choreographer Christoph Winkler. Carolin Jüngst was part of a research project with the choreographer Richard Siegal and the Göteborgs Danskompani/Opera Göteborg and holds a scholarship of the Claussen-Simon-Stiftung. She performed in works of Marina Abramovic, Allora & Calzadilla, or local artists such as Teresa Hoffmann.
